And in our grades ...

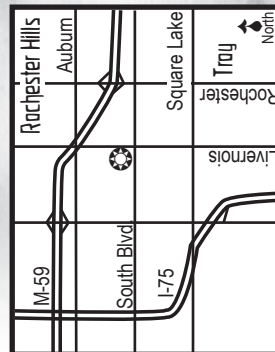
- ✦ Integration of science, math, history and all academic subjects with the arts, including music, drama, movement, sculpture and painting.

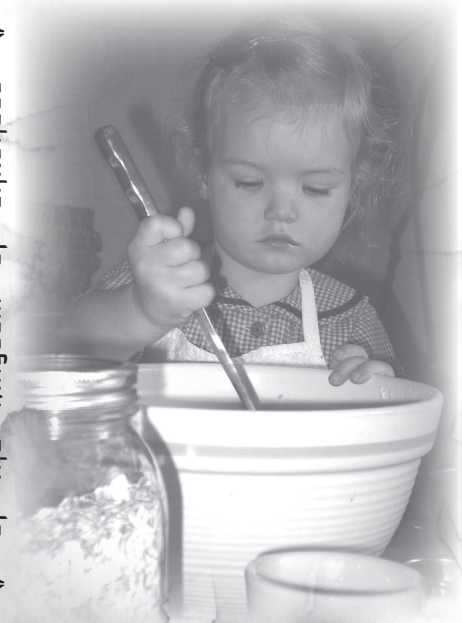

Parent-and-Child Classes

A gateway to Waldorf education

Created for children up to four years old and a parent, grandparent or caregiver

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A wondrous journey begins

In the Oakland Steiner Parent-and-Child program, opportunities abound for a child's natural exploration of his or her surroundings in the presence of a parent, grandparent or caregiver. Children will work side by side with the adult, under the guidance of our Waldorf teacher to make nutritious snacks, paint, make simple crafts, learn songs, verses and stories, and do everyday household tasks.

These simple activities nurture a child's sense of wonder and imagination, providing a content and secure connection to the world in which they live.

Classes give the families the opportunity to gain helpful insights into the developing child with a Waldorf approach through class examples and handout materials. The class can provide a gateway to families with young children to enter into our Waldorf school and community. It is an introduction to our nursery and preschool classes for children up to four years old with their parent or caregiver.

For close to a century, Waldorf schools around the globe have been working to safeguard childhood.
